## LENTEN REGULATIONS—2021

**ABSTINENCE:** The Church requires all the faithful who have reached their 14th year of age to abstain totally from meat on **all Fridays** during Lent.

**FASTING:** All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are also bound to observe the fasting regulation on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

The Church also requests that pastors and parents see to it that young persons who are not bound to follow the above requirements, are educated in an authentic sense of penance.

**EASTER DUTY:** After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion **at least** once a year. The precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year. Easter time begins at the Vigil on Holy Saturday and concludes with the celebration of Pentecost. By special indult, for the Dioceses in the United States, this period is extended to include the period from Ash Wednesday to Trinity Sunday.

### **The following should also be noted:**

By divine law, all the faithful are required to do penance. In view of this, the obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially" the penitential days specified by the Church, is a serious one.

In addition, all other Fridays of the year remain as days of penance in prayerful remembrance of the Passion of Jesus Christ. While abstinence, in a true spirit of penance, is commended, the Bishops of the United States have indicated that each individual may substitute for that tradition some other practice of voluntary self-denial or personal penance. This may involve acts of mortification, temperance, prayer or charity.

## STATIONS OF THE CROSS

During Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross in English every Friday after the 12:00pm Mass. Stations of the cross in Spanish every Friday during lent at 7:00pm in the Lower Church.

## REGULACIONES PARA LA CUARESMA— 2021

**ABSTINENCIA:** La Iglesia requiere que todos los fieles que hayan cumplido 14 años se abstengan totalmente de comer carne **todos los viernes** durante la Cuaresma.

**AYUNO:** Todos los fieles entre las edades de 18 y 59 inclusive también están obligados a observar la regulación del ayuno el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo.

Esta práctica implica limitarse a una sola comida completa y evitar la comida entre comidas. El sustento ligero también se puede tomar en otras dos ocasiones a lo largo del día.

La Iglesia también solicita que los pastores y los padres velen por que los jóvenes que no están obligados a seguir los requisitos anteriores, sean educados en un auténtico sentido de penitencia.

**SERVICIO DE PASCUA:** Después de haber sido iniciados en la Santísima Eucaristía, todos los fieles están obligados a recibir la Comunión **al menos** una vez al año. El precepto debe cumplirse durante la temporada de Pascua, a menos que por una buena razón se cumpla en otro momento durante el año. El tiempo de Pascua comienza en la Vigilia del Sábado Santo y concluye con la celebración de Pentecostés. Por un indulto especial, para las Diócesis en los Estados Unidos, este período se extiende para incluir el período del Miércoles de Ceniza al Domingo de la Trinidad.

### **También se debe tener en cuenta lo siguiente:**

Por ley divina, todos los fieles están obligados a hacer penitencia. En vista de esto, la obligación de observar, en su conjunto o "sustancialmente" los días penitenciales especificados por la Iglesia, es grave.

Además, todos los demás viernes del año permanecen como días de penitencia en recuerdo en oración de la Pasión de Jesucristo. Si bien se recomienda la abstinencia, en un verdadero espíritu de penitencia, los obispos de los Estados Unidos han indicado que cada individuo puede sustituir esa tradición por otra práctica de abnegación voluntaria o penitencia personal. Esto puede involucrar actos de mortificación, templanza, oración o caridad.

Cada año Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo y la Diócesis de Brooklyn se dedican a **La Campaña Católica Anual**, la cual sostiene programas católicos a través de Brooklyn y Queens, teniendo efecto en las vidas de un sin número de personas y familias, además de beneficiar a nuestra parroquia.



## ¿Cómo se beneficiará nuestra Parroquia?

Para que nuestra parroquia funcione, necesitamos sacerdotes y diáconos bien capacitados que puedan celebrar los sacramentos y administrar la parroquia. Sin los \$2.5 millones de la Campaña asignados a las vocaciones, no tendríamos los sacerdotes que nuestra parroquia necesita. Nuestros niños son el futuro de nuestra parroquia y estamos llamados a apoyarlos mientras crecen en la fe. La Campaña proporciona fondos que apoyan todos los programas de educación religiosa parroquial, así como asistencia para la matrícula para aquellos que buscan educación católica en academias y escuelas católicas. Más de \$2 millones de la Campaña se invierten en la fe de nuestros niños, además de brindar formación en la fe para adultos. Los programas de formación para laicos, incluidos los de nuestra propia parroquia, brindan capacitación en ministerios como los ministros y lectores eucarísticos o preparan a otros para los sacramentos.

La Campaña también proporciona los salarios de los Ministros Juveniles capacitados que trabajan en parroquias de Brooklyn y Queens. \$150,000 cada año de nuestras donaciones sostienen la Iniciativa de Ministerio Juvenil, que ha sido apoyada por Generaciones de Fe, asegurando que los jóvenes encuentren a Cristo a través de la Iglesia, formando lazos de fe de por vida que sostendrán nuestras parroquias en los años venideros.

Cristo mismo nos ha llamado a todos a cuidar a los necesitados, pero como una parroquia sola carecemos del tiempo, el espacio, las habilidades y los voluntarios que se necesitan para atender las necesidades de nuestros hermanos y hermanas que necesitan nuestra ayuda. Es por eso que, a través de la Campaña Católica Anual, nuestra parroquia apoya el trabajo de Caridades Católicas y Servicios Católicos de Migración que reciben un total de \$1.4 millones de la Campaña. Juntos podemos dar la bienvenida al extranjero, vestir al desnudo, alimentar al hambriento y albergar a los desamparados en el nombre de nuestra Iglesia. En nuestros esfuerzos por difundir el Evangelio de Cristo, también tenemos la responsabilidad como católicos de ministrar a los que están enfermos, a los estudiantes de las escuelas secundarias y universidades, así como a los que están encarcelados, tal como Cristo nos indicó. La Campaña proporciona \$1.9 millones para asegurar que los capellanes lleven los sacramentos de la iglesia a aquellos que están enfermos, encarcelados o están estudiando en escuela secundaria y la universidad.

## ¿Por qué mi participación es importante?

Como seguidores de Jesús aquí en Nuestra Se, entendemos que nuestra responsabilidad hacia nuestra parroquia implica una responsabilidad hacia la diócesis que nos une con toda la comunidad católica como el único cuerpo de Cristo.
