FROM THE OGLE OFFICE

Dear friends:

The Third Sunday of advent is known as **“Gaudete” Sunday**, from the first word of the entrance antiphon in Latin, a word meaning “Rejoice”. In our culture when Christmas is advertised from Halloween onward, it may seem unnecessary to tell people to rejoice, since that seems to be what we’re already doing. However, the tradition reminds us of a prior time when Advent was a serious season with more of a penitential character. *Gaudete* is approximately half-way through Advent and served the purpose of offering Christians some hope for the festival to come. So we should by all means rejoice as good Christians should, not with excess or self-indulgence, but with an awareness of God’s goodness to us both materially and most of all spiritually. The Incarnation of Christ is the most basic reason to rejoice.

The rejoicing will include our **virtual Christmas Tree lighting** via Facebook and the parish website on Thursday, December 17 at 6:50 PM. Although we won’t have any crowd gathering or goodies, you can watch the event take place via Internet and join us in a hopeful evening prayer for health and happiness to come.

Another annual reason to rejoice will be **“Reconciliation Monday”**, on Monday, December 21 from 3PM to 8PM in the lower church. Christ came to forgive our sins and reconcile the world to Himself. So let us not neglect the greatest Christmas gift of all.

On a more cautionary note, please be aware that Deacon Chin tested positive for coronavirus on Monday, December 7. He had tested negative the previous Monday, and believes he may have been exposed at a family gathering on Friday, December 4. He will quarantine for the prescribed time. Deacon Chin assisted at two Masses on Sunday December 6: 8 AM and 11:15 AM. All our usual protective measures were in place for both, as they will continue to be. Let’s do all we can to protect each other in a spirit of Christian charity and solidarity. And say a prayer for Chin and all our parishioners with this virus.

El tercer domingo de Adviento se conoce como domingo **“Gaudete”**, por la primera palabra de la antífona de entrada en latín, palabra que significa **“Regocíjate”**. En nuestra cultura, cuando se anuncia la Navidad desde Halloween en adelante, puede parecer innecesario decirle a la gente que se regocije, ya que eso parece ser lo que ya estamos haciendo. Sin embargo, la tradición nos recuerda una época anterior en la que el Adviento era una temporada seria con un carácter más penitencial. *Gaudete* se encuentra aproximadamente a la mitad del Adviento y tuvo el propósito de ofrecer a los cristianos algo de esperanza para la fiesta por venir. Por lo tanto, deberíamos por todos los medios regocijarnos como los buenos cristianos deberían, no con exceso o autocomplacencia, sino con una conciencia de la bondad de Dios para con nosotros tanto materialmente como sobre todo espiritualmente. La Encarnación de Cristo es la razón más básica para regocijarse.

El regocijo incluirá **la iluminación del árbol de Navidad** virtual a través de Facebook y el sitio web de la parroquia el jueves 17 de diciembre a las 6:50 pm. Aunque no tendremos reuniones de multitudes ni obsequios, puede ver el evento a través de Internet y unirse a nosotros en una oración vespertina esperanzadora por la salud y la felicidad venideras.

Otro motivo anual de regocijo será el **“Lunes de Reconciliación”**, el lunes 21 de diciembre de 3pm a 8pm en la iglesia de abajo. Cristo vino a perdonar nuestros pecados y reconciliar al mundo consigo mismo. Por tanto, no descuidemos el mayor regalo de Navidad de todos.

En una nota más de advertencia, tenga en cuenta que el diácono Chin dio positivo por coronavirus el lunes 7 de diciembre. Había dado negativo el lunes anterior y cree que pudo haber estado expuesto en una reunión familiar el viernes 4 de diciembre. Se pondrá en cuarentena por el tiempo prescrito. El diácono Chin asistió en dos Misas el domingo 6 de diciembre: 8 AM y 11:15 AM. Todas nuestras medidas de protección habituales estaban en vigor para ambos, y seguirán estando. Hagamos todo lo posible para protegernos unos a otros con un espíritu de caridad y solidaridad cristianas. Y reza una oración por Chin y todos nuestros feligreses con este virus.
