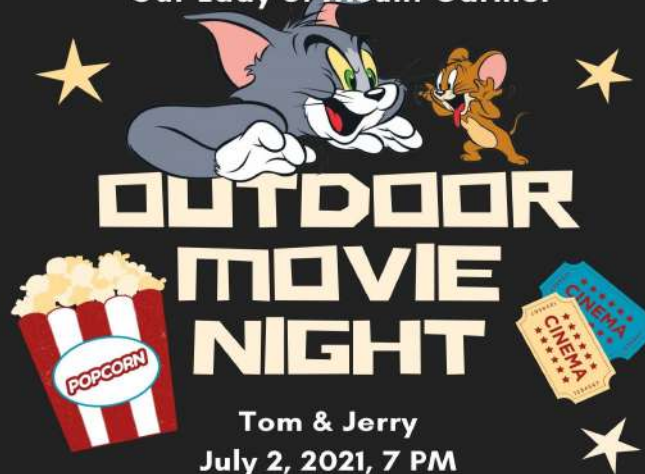

## *From the Ogle Office*

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

In the thirteen years I have been pastor here, I've been blessed with many assets and resources to address the pastoral matters that require service in our parish. In 2008 I found here a strong foundation for pastoral life in existing groups, and they have developed even more. The pastoral work of the parish carried out by our fine staff of priests, deacons and lay leaders enables the sacraments to be celebrated, the praises of God to be sung and the needs of poor to be met. Even that would be inadequate without the generosity of the parishioners here in their faith and good works. It is made manifest in hundreds of ways, both large and small. For example, your support of our food pantry and rummage at St Margaret Mary helps over two thousand people each month over the last thirty years, a pace that was only slightly lessened during the pandemic. On an interpersonal level, the mutual support I see dozens of parishioners offer each other week by week and day by day is a tribute to the bonds of friendship and affection that our faith gives rise to. I could go on and on. But here I would draw attention to two particular manifestations of your goodness and sense of service.

The first thing is collaboration and teamwork. People here tease me sometimes that I love to go to meetings. I really don't like meetings just for the sake of meetings any more than anyone else. But in our day and age, the way that a theology of communion is lived out effectively is by means of collaborative efforts, which means---- MEETINGS. It begins with a cohesive leadership staff. The parish staff has met bi-weekly with rare exceptions for the last thirteen years, except for the months of July and August. Even I was amazed when I saw that I have on file 254 agendas that we have discussed and acted on. More than carrying out chores, these were pastoral conversations where bonds of friendship and teamwork were forged, tested and strengthened. What happened at the leadership level also happened on the grassroots levels, with the existence of over thirty-four groups, committees and societies that are active in our parish. In any given week before the pandemic, we would typically have over eighty groups meeting (including religious education classes) in the institute and rectory. Most of those meetings were self-run, usually without the presence of a staff member, to plan and execute for some event, or to pray, discuss and live out elements of faith and community. In our church community, many neighbors became friends, old friends maintained connections, and new friends were made, especially among the newcomers to our area.

The second major element we have seen grow here is lay leadership training. Almost fifty persons have been certified in our diocesan Pastoral Institute/Holy Spirit Institute, for service in a particular area of parish life, and every single one of them has been or is currently involved in a parish apostolate, except for a few who have moved away. Few other parishes in our diocese have as many certified lay leaders, and this has been a great enrichment for our parish life. Many people on the margins of our parish life have as a result been brought closer to the parish fold by the work of these dedicated people. They have truly been my staff's hands and feet in parish pastoral outreach and service. I encourage more of you to take advantage of this training in the future.

In particular, I want to make note of the many blessings the Good Lord has showered on us in the last six weeks. It is as though he wished to offer us consolations and anointings (literally and figuratively) with such joyful moments as our Youth First Communions, Youth Confirmations, Adult Confirmations, and even rarer, ordinations in abundance: Seminarian Brendon Harfmann became transitional Deacon Brendon. Acolyte Jacob Rodriguez became Permanent Deacon Jacob. And Deacon Chin became Father Chin Nguyen, alongside fellow deacon Hung Tran who became Father Hung Tran, and who has been assigned to serve in our parish, succeeding Father Peter Nguyen. Indeed, we have had a plethora of spiritual riches offered us. Let us work together with our new pastor, Monsignor Cuong Pham, when he arrives on June 30 to continue being faithful instruments of the Lord's work here in western Astoria.

Queridos Amigos y Feligreses:

En los trece años que he sido pastor aquí, he sido bendecido con muchos recursos para abordar los asuntos pastorales que requieren servicio en nuestra parroquia. En 2008 encontré aquí una base sólida para la vida pastoral en los grupos existentes, y se han desarrollado aún más. El trabajo pastoral de la parroquia llevado a cabo por nuestro excelente equipo de sacerdotes, diáconos y líderes laicos permite celebrar los sacramentos, cantar alabanzas a Dios y satisfacer las necesidades de los pobres. Incluso eso sería inadecuado sin la generosidad de los feligreses aquí en su fe y buenas obras. Se manifiesta de cientos de formas, tanto grandes como pequeñas. Por ejemplo, su apoyo a nuestra despensa de alimentos y buscar en Sta Margarita María ayuda a más de dos mil personas cada mes durante los últimos treinta años, un ritmo que solo disminuyó ligeramente durante la pandemia. A nivel interpersonal, el apoyo mutuo que veo a decenas de feligreses brindarse semana a semana y día a día es un homenaje a los lazos de amistad y afecto que suscita nuestra fe. Podría seguir y seguir. Pero aquí quisiera llamar la atención sobre dos manifestaciones particulares de su bondad y sentido de servicio.

Lo primero es la colaboración y el trabajo en equipo. La gente de aquí se burla a veces de que me encanta ir a las reuniones. Realmente no me gustan las reuniones solo tener reuniones más que a cualquier otra persona. Pero en nuestros días, la forma en que se vive eficazmente una teología de la comunión es a través del esfuerzo colaborativo, lo que significa ---- REUNIONES. Comienza con un personal de liderazgo cohesionado. El personal de la parroquia se ha reunido cada dos semanas con raras excepciones durante los últimos trece años, excepto en los meses de julio y agosto. Incluso a mí me asombró ver que tengo archivadas 254 agendas que hemos discutido y sobre las que hemos actuado. Más que realizar quehaceres, fueron conversaciones pastorales donde se forjaron, probaron y fortalecieron lazos de amistad y trabajo en equipo. Lo que sucedió a nivel de liderazgo también sucedió a nivel de base, con la existencia de más de treinta y cuatro grupos, comités y sociedades que están activos en nuestra parroquia. En cualquier semana antes de la pandemia, normalmente tendríamos más de ochenta grupos reunidos (incluidas las clases de educación religiosa) en el instituto y la rectoría. La mayoría de esas reuniones fueron autogestionadas, generalmente sin la presencia de un miembro del personal, para planificar y ejecutar algún evento, o para orar, discutir y vivir elementos de fe y comunidad. En nuestra comunidad de la iglesia, muchos vecinos se hicieron amigos, viejos amigos mantuvieron conexiones y se hicieron nuevos amigos, especialmente entre los recién llegados a nuestra área.

El segundo elemento importante que hemos visto crecer aquí es la formación de líderes laicos. Casi cincuenta personas han sido certificadas en nuestro Instituto Pastoral Diocesano / Instituto del Espíritu Santo, para el servicio en un área particular de la vida parroquial, y cada una de ellas ha estado o está actualmente involucrada en un apostolado parroquial, excepto unas pocas que se han mudado. fuera. Pocas otras parroquias en nuestra diócesis tienen tantos líderes laicos certificados, y esto ha sido un gran enriquecimiento para nuestra vida parroquial. Como resultado, muchas personas al margen de nuestra vida parroquial se han acercado más al redil parroquial gracias al trabajo de estas personas dedicadas. Realmente han sido las manos y los pies de mi personal en el alcance y el servicio pastoral parroquial. Les animo a más de ustedes a que aprovechen esta capacitación en el futuro.

En particular, quiero tomar nota de las muchas bendiciones que el Buen Dios nos ha derramado en las últimas seis semanas. 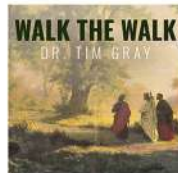
