From the Ogle Office

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion is the complete title for this day so beloved of Catholics and non-Catholics everywhere. It marks the start of the holiest time of the year for Christians, the celebration of the paschal mystery of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. As each year goes by, it seems as though we never had more need of its graces, and we find ourselves saying it once again this year: natural disasters, wars, domestic gun violence, social injustice, immoral social structures and laws even in our own dear country, and most prominently the Pandemic. We would love to change the world, but that journey must begin with changing myself. Where do we find the path to these graces?

The Word of God in Sacred Scripture is our most useful "key" to unlock the power of the paschal Mystery in our lives. Particularly during Holy week, each day we have those marvelous passages read at the liturgy called "The Songs of the Suffering Servant" from the Book of Isaiah. They prophesy a new and different kind of Messiah (Anointed One, or "Christ") who will bring back original harmony not by force of arms, but by means of the suffering he will endure for God's will.

That prophecy finds fulfillment in the person of Jesus of Nazareth, in a process called "kenosis", or self-emptying, that St Paul described in the marvelous passage that is the second reading on Palm Sunday. This "kenosis hymn" (sometime called the "Carmen Christi") describes the four-fold process of Jesus's saving action: His pre-existence, Incarnation, obedient death, and resurrection and exaltation as God over all creation.

Our part in this is to seek obediently God's will rather than our own, according to His commandments, aided by his divine grace, particularly in the sacraments. Please join us for the celebration of Holy Week services. As an act of charity, please pre-register for the services so that we can adhere to state and diocesan regulations for social distance, using both our upper and lower church (and if necessary also the Institute). Holy Communion will be distributed in each locale. May God grant each of you and yours a blessed Holy Week and Easter season.

De El Pastor

Queridos Amigos y Feligreses:

El Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión del Señor es el título completo de este día tan querido por católicos y no católicos de todo el mundo. Marca el inicio de la época más santa del año para los cristianos, la celebración del misterio pascual de la Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. A medida que pasa cada año, parece que nunca hemos tenido más necesidad de sus gracias, y nos encontramos repitiéndolo una vez más este año: desastres naturales, guerras, violencia doméstica con armas de fuego, injusticia social, estructuras sociales inmorales y leyes incluso en nuestro país propio querido país, y sobre todo la pandemia. Nos encantaría cambiar el mundo, pero ese viaje debe comenzar cambiándome a mí mismo. ¿Dónde encontramos el camino hacia estas gracias?

La Palabra de Dios en la Sagrada Escritura es nuestra "llave" más útil para desbloquear el poder del Misterio pascual en nuestras vidas. Particularmente durante la Semana Santa, todos los días se leen esos maravillosos pasajes en la liturgia llamados "Los Cánticos del Siervo que Sufrir" del Libro de Isaías. Ellos profetizan un nuevo y diferente tipo de Mesías (el Ungido o "Cristo") que traerá de regreso la armonía original no por la fuerza de las armas, sino por medio del sufrimiento que soportará por la voluntad de Dios.

Esa profecía encuentra su cumplimiento en la persona de Jesús de Nazaret, en un proceso llamado "kénosis", o auto-vaciamiento, que san Pablo describió en el maravilloso pasaje que es la segunda lectura del Domingo de Ramos. Este "himno de la kénosis" (en ocasiones llamado "Carmen Christi") describe el proceso cuádruple de la acción salvífica de Jesús: su preexistencia, encarnación, muerte obediente y resurrección y exaltación como Dios sobre toda la creación.

Nuestra parte en esto es buscar obedientemente la voluntad de Dios en lugar de la nuestra, de acuerdo con sus mandamientos, con la ayuda de su gracia divina, particularmente en los sacramentos. Únase a nosotros para la celebración de los servicios de Semana Santa. Como acto de caridad, por favor preinscríbese para los servicios para que podamos adherirnos a las regulaciones estatales y diocesanas para la distancia social, utilizando nuestra iglesia de arriba e de abajo (y si es necesario también el Instituto). La Sagrada Comunión se distribuirá en cada lugar. Que Dios les conceda a cada uno de ustedes y los suyos una Semana Santa y un tiempo de Pascua bendecidos.

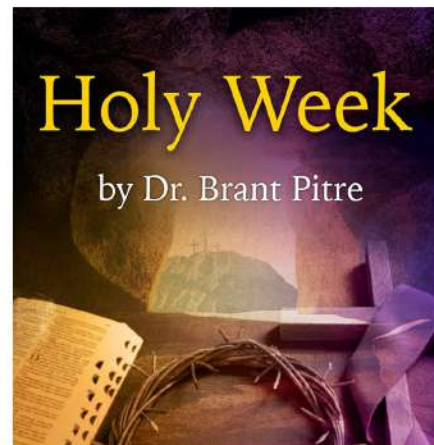
