We pray for you to have strength and wisdom on your new assignments and ask God to continue blessing you and your family in your new endeavors.

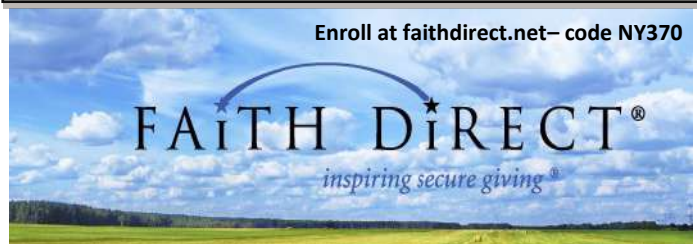
We would like to express one more time our immense gratitude for the commitment you have had to everyone of us during your 13 years of generous service. You will be greatly missed.

## *From the Ogle Office*

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

Last week we received notice from our diocese that, in line with the loosening of some Covid restrictions by NY State and NYC, the diocese is modifying certain elements of our pastoral practice as well, while maintaining other protocols. The modifications are:

- Hymns: We will provide a song-sheet for your taking with the opening and closing hymn for the Masses at Saturday 5 PM and Sunday 10 AM, 11:15 AM and 5 PM. These song-sheets should not be left in the pews but discarded carefully after Mass. Missalettes and hymnals will not be resumed as yet.
- "Choirs can resume singing at liturgies. Social distancing and mask-wearing must be maintained." Because of the limited space in the choirloft, the English choir will not resume at this time. The Spanish choir, which sings from the front, can resume with proper distance and masks.
- "Processions may resume for liturgies." We will start now with an exit procession at every Mass, but no entrance or offertory processions as yet.
- "Altar servers are permitted; however, they must be trained in the safety protocols" of masks, distancing and hand-disinfecting. "Lectors can resume reading from the main ambo" (the larger pulpit.)
- "Parish groups such as seniors can meet with safety precautions in place, especially if people are vaccinated." Leaders of groups should reserve meeting spaces in the Institute as always, calling the office to reserve a room.

We encourage you to give serious consideration to returning to in-person Mass attendance. Just as a family draws strength when united around the family dinner table, so too we Christians draw strength at the table of the Lord's Supper. Except for those who have underlying medical conditions, the advantages of personal participation in the liturgy are manifest: primarily physical reception of the Holy Eucharist, as well as worshipping with the people of God, building a sense of community, and the joy of communal worship. Safety-wise, our church is now equipped with the latest ventilation filters and U-V germicide lights, observes all possible protective protocols, and is disinfected daily. Please seriously consider returning to the family table of the Lord every Sunday.

Finally, please keep in your prayers:

- Seminarian Brendon Harfmann, who will offer his first diaconal sermon here on Sat. May 15 at 5 PM Mass. Deacon Brendon will meet-and-greet people in the gym after Mass.
- our First Communion children on the morning of May 22
- our adult *Confirmandi* on May 22 at the Pentecost Vigil Mass at 5 PM.

Queridos Amigos y Feligreses:

La semana pasada recibimos un aviso de nuestra diócesis de que, en línea con la flexibilización de algunas restricciones de Covid por parte del estado de Nueva York y la ciudad de Nueva York, la diócesis también está modificando ciertos elementos de nuestra práctica pastoral, al tiempo que mantiene otros protocolos. Las modificaciones son:

- Himnos: Le proporcionaremos una hoja para que la tomen con el himno de apertura y cierre de las Misas ingleses el sábado a las 5 pm y el domingo a las 10 am, 11:15 am y 5 pm. Estas hojas no deben dejarse en los bancos, sino desecharse con cuidado después de la Misa. Los missalitos y los himnarios no se reanudarán todavía.
- "Los coros pueden reanudar el canto en las liturgias. Se debe mantener el distanciamiento social y el uso de máscaras". Debido al espacio limitado en el coro, el coro en inglés no se reanuda en este momento. El coro español, que canta desde el frente, puede reanudar con la distancia y las máscaras adecuadas.
- "Las procesiones pueden reanudarse para las liturgias". Comenzaremos ahora con una procesión de salida en cada misa, pero aún no hay procesiones de entrada ni de ofertorio.
- "Se permiten monaguillos; sin embargo, deben estar capacitados en los protocolos de seguridad" de máscaras, distanciamiento y desinfección de manos.
- "Los lectores pueden reanudar la lectura desde el ambón principal" (el púlpito más grande).
- "Los grupos parroquiales, como los de personas mayores, pueden reunirse con las precauciones de seguridad establecidas, especialmente si las personas están vacunadas". Los líderes de los grupos deben reservar espacios de reunión en el Instituto como siempre, llamando a la oficina para reservar una sala.

Lo alentamos a que considere seriamente regresar a la asistencia a la Santa Misa en persona. Así como una familia se fortalece cuando se une alrededor de la mesa de la cena familiar, así también los cristianos sacamos fuerzas en la mesa de la Cena del Señor. Excepto para aquellos que tienen condiciones médicas subyacentes, las ventajas de la participación personal en la liturgia son manifiestas: principalmente la recepción física de la Sagrada Eucaristía, así como la adoración con el pueblo de Dios, la construcción de un sentido de comunidad y la alegría del culto comunitario. En cuanto a la seguridad, nuestra iglesia ahora está equipada con los últimos filtros de ventilación y luces germicidas U-V, observa todos los protocolos de protección posibles y se desinfecta a diario. Considere seriamente regresar a la mesa familiar del Señor todos los domingos.

Finalmente, mantenga sus oraciones:

- El seminarista Brendon Harfmann, quien ofrecerá su primer sermón diaconal aquí el sábado 15 de mayo a las 5 pm Misa. El Diácono Brendon se reunirá y saludará a la gente en el gimnasio después de la Misa.
- nuestros niños de Primera Comunión en la mañana del 22 de mayo
- nuestros *Confirmandi* adultos el 22 de mayo en la Misa de la Vigilia de Pentecostés a las 5 PM.

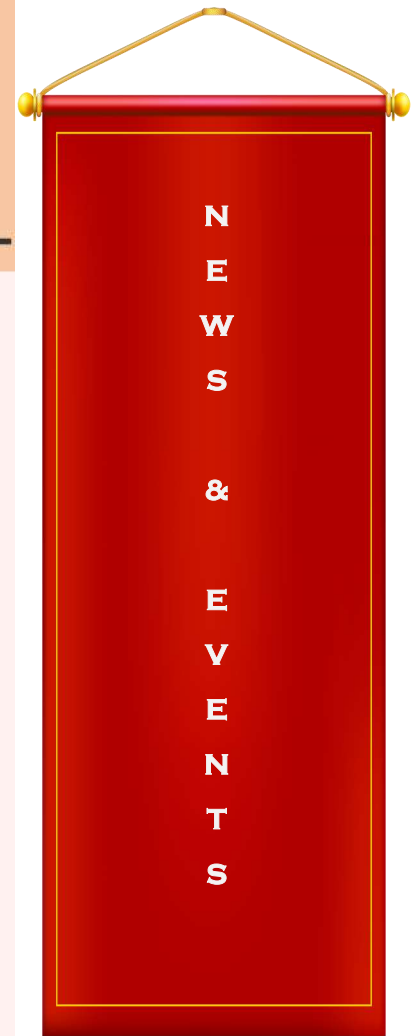
