BURIED IN YOUR BACKYARD

I remember watching a television show about a high school that dug up a time capsule that students had buried 25 years earlier. They had buried it with the purpose of showing others many years later the trends of the day and how student life was at that time. It was a fun exercise and everyone — the current students as well as those now grown — laughed at the clothing styles, corny photos, and lack of technology from years ago.

I wonder how the former students felt about how they had grown in those 25 years. How many of them realized their high school dreams? Did they find their purpose in this world and feel fulfilled in life? Did they use the

talents and gifts God gave them to really make a difference in the world?

We have all been given talents and gifts by God to be cultivated and offered back to Him and those around us for His glory. As time has passed, hopefully we have taken seriously our stewardship of these gifts. But sometimes out of fear, misunderstanding, or even apathy, we have taken one or more of our gifts and buried them, hiding them away from others and stifling all growth. This is no way to honor God and certainly not a path to fulfillment in life. If we have anything buried in our backyard, we might do well to dig it back up, clean it up, and begin building upon it. Like a time capsule, those things will not be buried forever. One day the giver of that gift will ask what you have done with it. When that day comes, I pray you don't need to find a shovel.

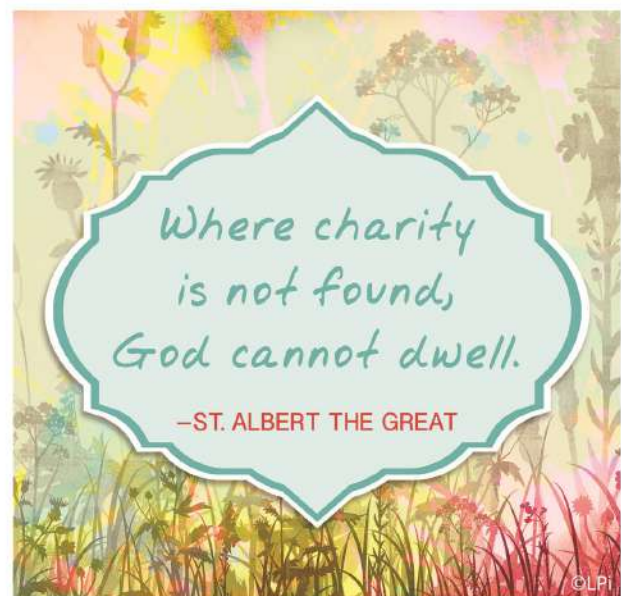
THE BIBLE SAYS THAT JESUS CONDEMNED GAMBLING, BUT I NOTICE THAT SO MANY PARISHES HAVE THEM AT FESTIVALS AND OTHER EVENTS. WHAT'S CORRECT?

Although Jesus speaks of our relationship with material wealth and the very human struggle with greed, the gospels do not include any specific instructions related to gambling. At the same time, the Church is very sensitive to the needs of those who might struggle with an addiction to gambling, and pastoral care should always be offered to those who struggle with this reality in their life.

While it is true that many parish or school communities include gambling or games of chance in festivals and fundraisers (e.g. bingo, roulette, ring tossing, dunking booths, etc.), there is nothing inherently wrong with these sorts of events, given they are played fairly and within the limits of reason are not morally objectionable. As the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* reminds us: "Games of chance (card games, etc.) or wagers are not in themselves contrary to justice. They become morally unacceptable when they deprive someone of what

is necessary to provide for his needs and those of others" (no. 2413).

As in all things, moderation and a sense of healthy limits should be applied to gambling and games of chance. For those who find themselves living with addiction to gambling, help is available in various 12-step and addiction recovery programs.



FROM THE OGLE OFFICE

Dear friends:

This is the time of the year when we normally have our **Scripture Sharing Groups** for the pre-Advent season. These small groups have proven very popular since starting in 2016 during our 175th anniversary year, and in fact the Spanish-language groups have indeed been meeting as currently permitted by the state and the diocese, with reduced numbers, and using all current safety procedures. After consulting with some parish leaders, I decided to conduct the English-language groups via Zoom (that is, via computer or phone) rather than in-person, and to have them during Advent itself rather than pre-Advent. Rather than numerous small groups, we will have a single group which I will lead in a Bible-study of the following Sunday's readings for the Sundays of Advent. We'll meet on Monday nights from 7:30 to 8:45 PM. The meeting dates are: Mondays: Nov. 23, Nov. 30, Dec. 7, Dec. 14, Dec. 21.

In order to participate, you will need to download the Zoom app on your computer or smartphone. We will post the access information (the same for all five meetings) on posters at the church doors that you can copy. Or you may simply call the rectory office, providing your email address so we can send you the access information. We will also send the access information to those persons who were part of last year's groups for whom we have an email address. Each session will use a short video reflection which I will share with you on the screen, followed by some reflections and sharing. This who do not have a computer or smartphone can simply phone into the meeting by telephone only, but will be unable to see the video portion of the meeting. You will, however, be able to hear and speak during the rest of the meeting. I do hope many of you can join us. (It is my hope that when we approach Lent, we will be able once again to meet in person, with all safety precautions taken, of course.)

As I mentioned in my letter last week, we will start distributing the **paper bulletin** again this weekend in Church. However, distribution of either must be done in such a way as to minimize possible contagion. Thus: you should take the bulletin **AFTER** Mass, not before. Secondly, you must take the bulletin yourself, not receive it from an usher. Third, once you take it, you must bring it home. Any bulletins left in the benches will be immediately thrown in the garbage by the volunteer cleaners. Finally, please read the bulletin for parish news and patronize our advertisers who have supported us for many months despite the limited circulation of their ads.

Finally, I want to thank all those who have pledged to the **Annual Catholic Appeal**. We have reached 228 pledges totaling \$65,772.00 or 101.8% of our goal. This is a wonderful accomplishment in the time of economic hardship and pandemic. Knowing the good works supported by the Appeal that impact our parish too, I hope more of you will join in the effort. For example, Catholic Charities has secured extra deliveries of food and food vouchers for our needy families throughout the pandemic, as well as rent-assistance grants, free flu shots and immigrant rights workshops. Likewise seminarian formation (including new Deacon Chin) is supported by your contribution. ACA envelopes are still available at the church doors for your taking.

DE LA OFICINA DEL PASTOR

Queridos amigos,

Esta es la época del año en la que normalmente tenemos nuestros grupos para compartir las Escrituras para la temporada previa al Adviento. Estos grupos pequeños han demostrado ser muy populares desde que comenzaron en 2016 durante nuestro año 175 aniversario, y de hecho, los grupos en español se han estado reuniendo con **"Porque Ser Católico?"** como lo permiten actualmente el estado y la diócesis, con números reducidos y utilizando todos los procedimientos de seguridad actuales.

Después de consultar con algunos líderes parroquiales, decidí dirigir los grupos en inglés a través de Zoom (es decir, por computadora o teléfono) en lugar de en persona, y tenerlos durante el Adviento mismo en lugar de antes del Adviento. En lugar de numerosos grupos pequeños, tendremos un solo grupo que dirigiré en un estudio bíblico de las lecturas del domingo siguiente para los domingos de Adviento. Nos reuniremos los lunes por la noche de 7:30 a 8:45 p.m. Las fechas de las reuniones son: Lunes: 23 de noviembre, 30 de noviembre, 7 de diciembre, 14 de diciembre, 21 de diciembre. Tengo la esperanza de que cuando nos acerquemos a la Cuaresma, podamos volver a reunirnos en persona y, por supuesto, tomar todas las precauciones de seguridad.

Como mencioné en mi carta la semana pasada, comenzaremos a distribuir el **boletín impreso** nuevamente este fin de semana en la Iglesia. Sin embargo, la distribución de cualquiera de los dos debe realizarse de tal manera que se minimice el posible contagio. Por lo tanto: debe llevar el boletín DESPUÉS de la Misa, no antes. En segundo lugar, debe tomar el boletín usted mismo, no recibirlo de un acomodador. En tercer lugar, una vez que lo tome, debe llevarlo a casa. Los limpiadores voluntarios arrojarán inmediatamente a la basura los boletines que se dejen en los bancos. Finalmente, lea el boletín de noticias parroquiales y patrocine a nuestros anunciantes que nos han apoyado durante muchos meses a pesar de la circulación limitada de sus anuncios.

Finalmente, quiero agradecer a todos aquellos que se han comprometido con la **Campaña Católica Anual**. Hemos alcanzado 228 promesas por un total de \$ 65,772.00 o el 101.8% de nuestra meta. Este es un logro maravilloso en tiempos de dificultades económicas y pandemias. Conociendo las buenas obras apoyadas por la Campaña que también impactan a nuestra parroquia, espero que más de ustedes se unan al esfuerzo. Por ejemplo, Caridades Católicas ha asegurado entregas adicionales de alimentos y vales de alimentos para nuestras familias necesitadas durante la pandemia, así como subvenciones de asistencia para el alquiler, vacunas gratuitas contra la gripe y talleres sobre los derechos de los inmigrantes. Asimismo, la formación de seminaristas (incluido el nuevo Diácono Chin) es apoyada por su contribución. Los sobres de ACA todavía están disponibles en las puertas de la iglesia para que los lleve.

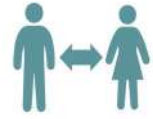
