## **FROM THE OGLE OFFICE**

Dear friends:

Please join us via Facebook and our parish website for our second annual Christmas tree lighting on Thursday, December 17 at 6:50 PM. Unlike last year, the crowd will be limited to the members of our Confirmation class, masked and socially distant, and there will be no goodies to share afterwards. But we will share the growing joy of the approaching Incarnation of Our Savior as we livestream the event on the parish website and Facebook page.

I'm also happy to report a distinct milestone in our parish. Last weekend at Mass for the first time since the March 15 NYS lockdown, we reached 50% of our usual average Mass attendance, with 750 persons at our ten Masses. Although 2020 has been a year like no other, yet as disciples of Christ we still have the familiar yearning to worship Him and receive the graces we need for daily living and eternal life. Thus, even though the obligation to attend Sunday Mass is lifted for Catholics during the pandemic, yet our intrinsic need to worship remains strong and necessary for a happy life. So we continue to livestream all our scheduled Masses every day as a service to those at risk medically, to the far-distant and as another method of evangelization. But we also encourage those who can to return to Church in-person and receive Holy Communion sacramentally. We assure everyone that we observe every prescribed safety precaution, and we sanitize after every Mass and every morning as well. As a result in the five months since we reopened on June 26, there have been only two reported cases of infection of worshippers here. We intend to maintain the safest possible environment for everyone.

A big element of safety is the number of persons at each Mass. We have worked hard to remain within the current state limit for houses of worship of 50% capacity with proper social distance between each household. As our Mass attendance continues to grow slowly but surely, we probably will need to start doing at some English Masses what we already have done since the beginning at the 12:30 Spanish Mass. When we reach capacity upstairs, the "overflow" are sent downstairs to watch the upstairs Mass on the livestream projection screen and to receive Holy Communion from the lay ministers. When the lower church reaches capacity, we have the same procedure set up in the Institute gymnasium. In order to facilitate this procedure and avoid surprises when you arrive at church, we invite you to pre-register for Mass by calling the parish office by Thursday each week. I know this is not our customary practice as Catholics, but it is another attempt both to keep everyone safe and to avoid surprises at the Church doors. Thank you for your cooperation.

Finally, I remind you that all are welcome to join us for our remote Bible Study every Monday night at 7:30 PM via Zoom as we review the Bible readings for the following Sunday. Just install the Zoom app on your device and then use this information to access:

## **DE LA OFICINA DEL PASTOR**

Queridos Amigos y Feligreses:

Únase a nosotros a través de Facebook y nuestro sitio web parroquial para nuestra segunda iluminación anual del árbol de Navidad el jueves 17 de diciembre a las 6:50 PM. A diferencia del año pasado, la multitud estará limitada a los treinta miembros de nuestra clase de Confirmación, enmascarados y socialmente distantes, y no habrá golosinas para compartir después. Pero compartiremos el creciente gozo de la Encarnación que se acerca de Nuestro Salvador mientras vivimos el evento en el sitio web de la parroquia y en la página de Facebook.

También me complace informar de un hito distinto en nuestra parroquia. El fin de semana pasado en la misa por primera vez desde el cierre del estado de Nueva York el 15 de marzo, alcanzamos el 50% de nuestra asistencia promedio habitual a misa, con 750 personas en nuestras diez Misas. Aunque 2020 ha sido un año como ningún otro, como discípulos de Cristo todavía tenemos el anhelo familiar de adorarlo y recibir las gracias que necesitamos para la vida diaria y la vida eterna. Por lo tanto, aunque la obligación de asistir a la Santa Misa dominical se elimina para los católicos durante la pandemia, nuestra necesidad intrínseca de adorar sigue siendo fuerte y necesaria para una vida feliz. Así que continuamos transmitiendo en vivo todas nuestras Misas programadas todos los días como un servicio a los que están en riesgo médico, a los más distantes y como otro método de evangelización. Pero también animamos a aquellos que puedan a regresar a la Iglesia en persona y recibir la Sagrada Comunión sacramentalmente. Les aseguramos a todos que observamos todas las precauciones de seguridad prescritas, y desinfectamos después de cada misa y también cada mañana. Como resultado, en los cinco meses desde que reabrimos el 26 de junio, solo se han reportado dos casos de infección de fieles aquí. Tenemos la intención de mantener el entorno más seguro posible para todos.

Un gran elemento de seguridad es el número de personas en cada Misa. Hemos trabajado duro para mantenernos dentro del límite estatal de 50% de capacidad con una distancia social adecuada entre cada hogar. A medida que nuestra asistencia a la Santa Misa continúa creciendo lenta pero seguramente, probablemente tendremos que comenzar a hacer en algunas Misas en inglés lo que ya hemos hecho desde el principio en la Misa en español de las 12:30. Cuando alcancemos la capacidad en el piso de arriba, se envían los "desbordes" abajo para ver la Misa de arriba en la pantalla de proyección en vivo y recibir la Sagrada Comunión de los ministros laicos. Cuando la iglesia de abajo alcanza su capacidad, tenemos el mismo procedimiento establecido en el gimnasio del Instituto. Lo invitamos a registrarse previamente para la Misa llamando a la oficina parroquial antes del jueves de cada semana. Es una manera de mantener a todos a salvo como de evitar sorpresas en las puertas de la Iglesia. En particular, requerimos preinscripción para las Misas a las 7:00 PM del sábado 12 de diciembre para Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en las iglesias de arriba y abajo y en el gimnasio del Instituto y Santa Margarita María. Gracias por su cooperación.

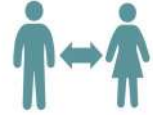
