LENTEN REGULATIONS—2021

ABSTINENCE: The Church requires all the faithful who have reached their 14th year of age to abstain totally from meat on **all Fridays** during Lent.

FASTING: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are also bound to observe the fasting regulation on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

The Church also requests that pastors and parents see to it that young persons who are not bound to follow the above requirements, are educated in an authentic sense of penance.

EASTER DUTY: After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion **at least** once a year. The precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year. Easter time begins at the Vigil on Holy Saturday and concludes with the celebration of Pentecost. By special indult, for the Dioceses in the United States, this period is extended to include the period from Ash Wednesday to Trinity Sunday.

The following should also be noted:

By divine law, all the faithful are required to do penance. In view of this, the obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially" the penitential days specified by the Church, is a serious one.

In addition, all other Fridays of the year remain as days of penance in prayerful remembrance of the Passion of Jesus Christ. While abstinence, in a true spirit of penance, is commended, the Bishops of the United States have indicated that each individual may substitute for that tradition some other practice of voluntary self-denial or personal penance. This may involve acts of mortification, temperance, prayer or charity.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

During Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross in English every Friday after the 12:00pm Mass. Stations of the cross in Spanish every Friday during lent at 7:00pm in the Lower Church.

REGULACIONES PARA LA CUARESMA— 2021

ABSTINENCIA: La Iglesia requiere que todos los fieles que hayan cumplido 14 años se abstengan totalmente de comer carne **todos los viernes** durante la Cuaresma.

AYUNO: Todos los fieles entre las edades de 18 y 59 inclusive también están obligados a observar la regulación del ayuno el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo.

Esta práctica implica limitarse a una sola comida completa y evitar la comida entre comidas. El sustento ligero también se puede tomar en otras dos ocasiones a lo largo del día.

La Iglesia también solicita que los pastores y los padres velen por que los jóvenes que no están obligados a seguir los requisitos anteriores, sean educados en un auténtico sentido de penitencia.

SERVICIO DE PASCUA: Después de haber sido iniciados en la Santísima Eucaristía, todos los fieles están obligados a recibir la Comunión **al menos** una vez al año. El precepto debe cumplirse durante la temporada de Pascua, a menos que por una buena razón se cumpla en otro momento durante el año. El tiempo de Pascua comienza en la Vigilia del Sábado Santo y concluye con la celebración de Pentecostés. Por un indulto especial, para las Diócesis en los Estados Unidos, este período se extiende para incluir el período del Miércoles de Ceniza al Domingo de la Trinidad.

También se debe tener en cuenta lo siguiente:

Por ley divina, todos los fieles están obligados a hacer penitencia. En vista de esto, la obligación de observar, en su conjunto o "sustancialmente" los días penitenciales especificados por la Iglesia, es grave.

Además, todos los demás viernes del año permanecen como días de penitencia en recuerdo en oración de la Pasión de Jesucristo. Si bien se recomienda la abstinencia, en un verdadero espíritu de penitencia, los obispos de los Estados Unidos han indicado que cada individuo puede sustituir esa tradición por otra práctica de abnegación voluntaria o penitencia personal. Esto puede involucrar actos de mortificación, templanza, oración o caridad.

From the Ogle Office

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

As we move into the spring it seems as though there is hope for a lightening up of the pandemic. NY State continues to adjust its rules for gatherings. For example, the maximum for indoor gatherings has now been raised to 50% of capacity for churches (from 25%), while still retaining the six-foot distance. Both NY State and Brooklyn Diocesan rules for gathering require six-foot distance between people who do not live in the same household. Thus we have marked off six-feet between places, giving us 90 places for seating in the upstairs church. Those 90 places are marked by "blue crosses", three to each pew. **Please note:** Each place could be either one person, or a couple who live together, or a household of any size who live together. Thus in a given row, you could have as few as three individuals, or as many as twelve if they all live in the same household. When we have registered 90 places upstairs, we register the overflow downstairs to watch the livestream and receive Holy Communion. But there could be more than 90 individuals legally and safely present if there are households sitting together.

In order to accommodate that reality, instead of taking 90 as our cut-off for Mass registration, we will henceforth register households who live together as one "place", and register up to 90 "places" upstairs before registering people for downstairs church, up to the current maximum permitted by the State and Diocese. Currently, only the Spanish Mass has had to use the lower church (and even the Institute) for the live-streamed Mass with distribution of Holy Communion. But during Holy Week that may become an issue for English services as well. So we ask you in your charity to maintain safe social distance in church by registering for Mass early in the week and following the directives of our secretary and ushers about where to be seated for Mass. We thank you for your cooperation. We also hope and pray for the lifting of these restrictions as soon as it becomes safe to do so.

Finally, we ask your support for the Knights of Columbus Colon-Higgins Council Sweater Drive for Veterans next Sunday, March 21 at all Masses.

De El Pastor

Queridos Amigos y Feligreses:

A medida que avanzamos hacia la primavera, parece que hay esperanzas de que la pandemia se aclare. El estado de Nueva York continúa ajustando sus reglas para las reuniones. Por ejemplo, el máximo para reuniones en interiores ahora se ha elevado al 50% de la capacidad para las iglesias (desde el 25%), mientras se mantiene la distancia de seis pies. Tanto las reglas del estado de Nueva York como las de la diócesis de Brooklyn para las reuniones requieren una distancia de seis pies entre las personas que no viven en el mismo hogar. Por lo tanto, hemos marcado dos metros entre los lugares, dándonos 90 lugares para sentarnos en la iglesia de arriba. Esos 90 lugares están marcados con "cruces azules", tres en cada banco. **Tenga en cuenta:** cada lugar puede ser una persona, una pareja que vive junta o un hogar de cualquier tamaño que viva junta. Por lo tanto, en una fila determinada, podría tener tan solo tres personas, o hasta doce si todas viven en el mismo hogar. Cuando hemos registrado 90 lugares arriba, registramos el desbordamiento de abajo para ver la transmisión en vivo y recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Pero podría haber más de 90 personas presentes de manera legal y segura si hay hogares sentados juntos.

Para acomodar esa realidad, en lugar de tomar 90 como nuestro límite para el registro de la Misa, de ahora en adelante registraremos a los hogares que viven juntos como un "lugar", y registraremos hasta 90 "lugares" en el piso de arriba antes de registrar a las personas para la iglesia de abajo. hasta el máximo actual permitido por el Estado y la Diócesis. Actualmente, solo la Misa en español ha tenido que usar la iglesia baja (e incluso el Instituto) para la Misa transmitida en vivo con distribución de la Sagrada Comunión. Pero durante la Semana Santa eso también puede convertirse en un problema para los servicios en inglés. Así que le pedimos en su organización benéfica que mantenga una distancia social segura en la iglesia registrándose para la Misa a principios de la semana y siguiendo las instrucciones de nuestra secretaria y ujieres sobre dónde sentarse para la Misa. Les agradecemos su cooperación. También esperamos y oramos por el levantamiento de estas restricciones tan pronto como sea seguro hacerlo.

Finalmente, les pedimos su apoyo para la colecta de suéteres para veteranos del Comité Colon-Higgins de **Caballeros de Colón** el próximo domingo 21 de marzo en todas las Misas.

Sunday Scripture Reading Reflections

Below you will find the access information for our Lent Scripture Study. We will look at the Scripture readings of the following Sunday.
