## LENTEN REGULATIONS—2021

**ABSTINENCE:** The Church requires all the faithful who have reached their 14th year of age to abstain totally from meat on **all Fridays** during Lent.

**FASTING:** All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are also bound to observe the fasting regulation on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

The Church also requests that pastors and parents see to it that young persons who are not bound to follow the above requirements, are educated in an authentic sense of penance.

**EASTER DUTY:** After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion **at least** once a year. The precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year. Easter time begins at the Vigil on Holy Saturday and concludes with the celebration of Pentecost. By special indult, for the Dioceses in the United States, this period is extended to include the period from Ash Wednesday to Trinity Sunday.

### **The following should also be noted:**

By divine law, all the faithful are required to do penance. In view of this, the obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially" the penitential days specified by the Church, is a serious one.

In addition, all other Fridays of the year remain as days of penance in prayerful remembrance of the Passion of Jesus Christ. While abstinence, in a true spirit of penance, is commended, the Bishops of the United States have indicated that each individual may substitute for that tradition some other practice of voluntary self-denial or personal penance. This may involve acts of mortification, temperance, prayer or charity.

## STATIONS OF THE CROSS

During Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross in English every Friday after the 12:00pm Mass. Stations of the cross in Spanish every Friday during lent at 7:00pm in the Lower Church.

## REGULACIONES PARA LA CUARESMA— 2021

**ABSTINENCIA:** La Iglesia requiere que todos los fieles que hayan cumplido 14 años se abstengan totalmente de comer carne **todos los viernes** durante la Cuaresma.

**AYUNO:** Todos los fieles entre las edades de 18 y 59 inclusive también están obligados a observar la regulación del ayuno el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo.

Esta práctica implica limitarse a una sola comida completa y evitar la comida entre comidas. El sustento ligero también se puede tomar en otras dos ocasiones a lo largo del día.

La Iglesia también solicita que los pastores y los padres velen por que los jóvenes que no están obligados a seguir los requisitos anteriores, sean educados en un auténtico sentido de penitencia.

**SERVICIO DE PASCUA:** Después de haber sido iniciados en la Santísima Eucaristía, todos los fieles están obligados a recibir la Comunión **al menos** una vez al año. El precepto debe cumplirse durante la temporada de Pascua, a menos que por una buena razón se cumpla en otro momento durante el año. El tiempo de Pascua comienza en la Vigilia del Sábado Santo y concluye con la celebración de Pentecostés. Por un indulto especial, para las Diócesis en los Estados Unidos, este período se extiende para incluir el período del Miércoles de Ceniza al Domingo de la Trinidad.

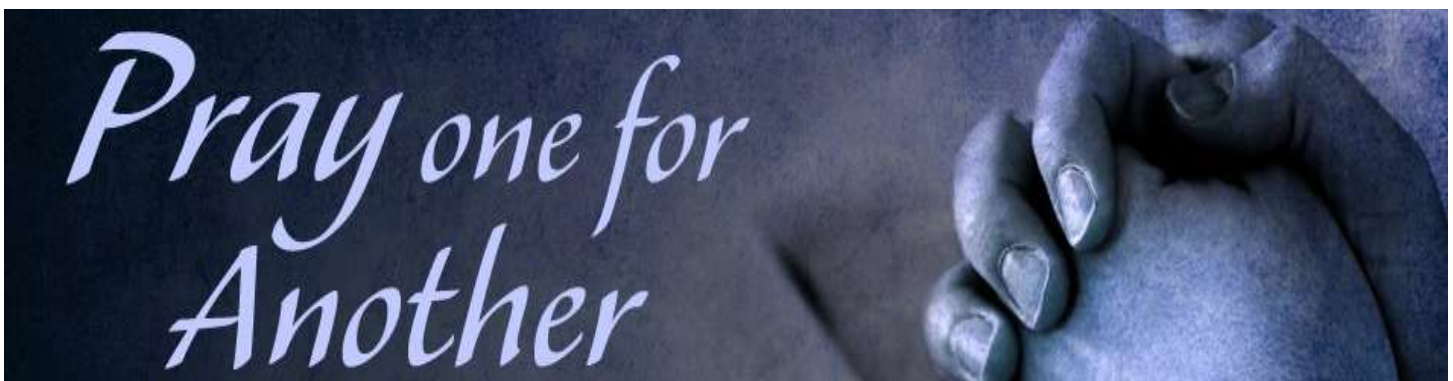
### **También se debe tener en cuenta lo siguiente:**

Por ley divina, todos los fieles están obligados a hacer penitencia. En vista de esto, la obligación de observar, en su conjunto o "sustancialmente" los días penitenciales especificados por la Iglesia, es grave.

Además, todos los demás viernes del año permanecen como días de penitencia en recuerdo en oración de la Pasión de Jesucristo. Si bien se recomienda la abstinencia, en un verdadero espíritu de penitencia, los obispos de los Estados Unidos han indicado que cada individuo puede sustituir esa tradición por otra práctica de abnegación voluntaria o penitencia personal. Esto puede involucrar actos de mortificación, templanza, oración o caridad.

## From the Ogle Office

## De El Pastor

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

Next Sunday, Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, marks the beginning of Holy Week, our most sacred time of the year. 2020 brought us a strange kind of Holy Week: unable to celebrate in person, livestreaming our services without a congregation, music or sacraments of initiation. The Easter sacraments of our RCIA elect were postponed until the summer.

This year, thanks be to God, we are able to do much more, as the vaccinations and better weather enable our weekly Mass attendance figures slowly climb back toward fifty percent of normal. But caution is still in order, and so we have certain directives from our Diocese that parishes are to observe in order to maintain our excellent track record of Covid safety in the Catholic parishes of Brooklyn and Queens. Thus you will notice a few changes in our Holy Week liturgies this year, in addition to our standard Covid safety measures of masks, sanitizing and social distance between household units:

1. Palm Sunday: The ushers will be wearing gloves as they hand you palm entering the church. No palm may be left behind in the pews; if so, it will be thrown away.
2. Holy Thursday: there will be no Washing of the Feet, and only a short procession to the place of reposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the end of Mass. (There will, however, be public adoration until midnight as usual.)
3. Good Friday: The faithful will venerate the Cross from their seats, without coming forward to kiss it individually. There will be no outdoors Living Stations of the Cross through the streets, but the 12 Noon English Stations will be conducted as usual.
4. Holy Saturday Vigil Mass: The Sacraments of Initiation will be conferred on our RCIA Elect. But there will not be a congregational lighting of candles, either at the beginning of the Vigil or at the renewal of baptismal vows.

Please know that these adaptations are in place for the safety of all at this critical time and are for this year only.

El próximo domingo, Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión del Señor, marca el inicio de la Semana Santa, nuestra época más sagrada del año. El 2020 nos trajo un tipo extraño de Semana Santa: no poder celebrar en persona, retransmitir en directo nuestros servicios sin congregación, música o sacramentos de iniciación. Los sacramentos de Pascua de nuestros elegidos de RICA se pospusieron hasta el verano.

Este año, gracias a Dios, podemos hacer mucho más, ya que las vacunas y el mejor clima permiten que nuestras cifras semanales de asistencia a misa regresen lentamente al cincuenta por ciento de lo normal. Pero la precaución aún es necesaria, por lo que tenemos ciertas directivas de nuestra Diócesis que las parroquias deben observar para mantener nuestro excelente historial de seguridad de Covid en las parroquias católicas de Brooklyn y Queens. Por lo tanto, notará algunos cambios en nuestras liturgias de Semana Santa este año, además de nuestras medidas de seguridad estándar de Covid de máscaras, desinfección y distancia social entre las unidades del hogar:

1. Domingo de Ramos: Los acomodadores llevarán guantes mientras te dan la palma de la mano al entrar a la iglesia. No se puede dejar ninguna palma en los bancos; si es así, será desechado.
2. Jueves Santo: no habrá lavado de pies, y solo una corta procesión hasta el lugar de reposo del Santísimo Sacramento al final de la Misa. (Sin embargo, habrá adoración pública hasta la medianoche como de costumbre).
3. Viernes Santo: Los fieles venerarán la Cruz desde sus asientos, sin acercarse a besarla individualmente. No habrá Estaciones de la Cruz Vivientes al aire libre a través de las calles, pero las Estaciones interior de Inglés a las 12:00 horas se llevarán a cabo como de costumbre. (También hay Dolores de la Virgen el martes y Vía Crucis en español miércoles por la tarde.)
4. Misa de Vigilia del Sábado Santo: Los Sacramentos de Iniciación serán conferidos a nuestros Electos de RICA. Pero no habrá un encendido congregacional de velas, ni al comienzo de la Vigilia ni en la renovación de los votos bautismales.

Tenga en cuenta que estas adaptaciones están en su lugar para la seguridad de todos en este momento crítico y son sólo para este año.
