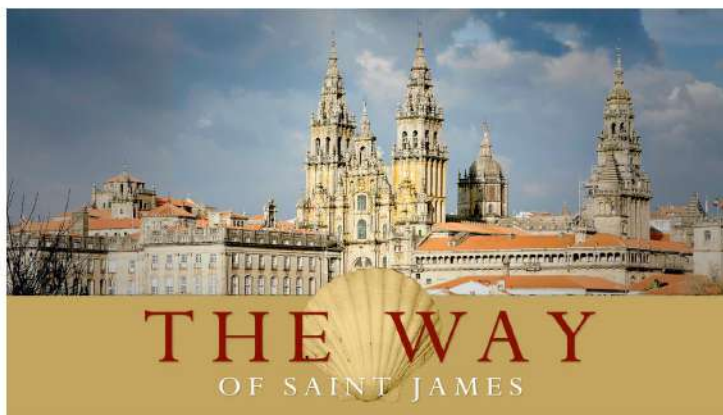

## *From the Ogle Office*

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

On this Good Shepherd Sunday, I wish to speak with you about a particular aspect of the life of a pastor. Thirteen years ago Bishop DiMarzio assigned me as pastor to this parish. It has been a great gift for me to be here and I thank God for bringing me here. It was purely through God's goodness and the Bishop's concern for this great parish that I have had the privilege to serve you.

Now Bishop DiMarzio has turned to me again with a new task. He is asking me to take on two diocesan jobs: first to succeed Bishop Chappetto as the Vicar for Clergy, that is, in charge of the continuing education, the assignment, and the special needs of priests and deacons. In other words, to be a shepherd to the shepherd, to help provide what they need in order to be better shepherds in their parishes. Secondly, he has asked me to succeed Msgr. Kieran Harrington as the president and Chairman of the Board of DeSales Media, comprising the *Tablet/Nuestra Voz* and the NET-TV, and its other activities. I was completely surprised by these appointments and in no way did I seek them. My personal preference would be to stay here for the remaining five years before I reach retirement age of 75. However, in the same way that I came here at the direction of our Bishop, so too I must be accepting of his larger vision for the needs of the priests and people of God in our diocese. But I will sorely miss every one of you and the vibrant life of this beautiful parish.

I will be your pastor until June 30. At that time your new pastor will come here. His name is Monsignor Cuong Pham, born in Vietnam but raised here in Queens, a priest of the Brooklyn Diocese, who attended our diocesan seminaries and was ordained twenty years ago. He is fluent in many languages. Please give him your utmost cooperation and support as you have done with me from my first day with you thirteen years ago.

I have another piece of related news. In addition to my own departure, Father Peter Nguyen also is being transferred from here to become an associate at the parish of St Francis of Assisi in Astoria, also effective June 30. He too has been here in this parish for thirteen years, and even longer as a religious brother before that. I am grateful to him for his great help to me throughout these years, for he has truly been an indispensable brother priest for me. There will be a replacement for Father Peter, but he has not yet been named.

I said to you last Sunday in speaking of the ACA that "*pastors, priests, deacons and staff come and go, but the spiritual and pastoral needs of God's people remain.*" So too for 181 years this parish has been served by many fine pastors and associates, like Fathers Peter, Mike, Wlad, Joe, Brady and more, serving generous, faith-filled people like yourselves. As Father Peter and I move on in obedience to our Bishop, we are proud of what has been accomplished here over the last thirteen years by all of us, clergy, staff and laity, together. I am sad to leave behind so many friends, but heartened by the knowledge that, when we do God's will rather than our own, God will bring all things to a good end. Thank you for your support and please let us keep each other in prayer.

En otras palabras, ser pastor para los pastores, ayudar a proporcionar lo que necesitan para ser mejores pastores en sus parroquias. En segundo lugar, me ha pedido que suceda a Mons. Kieran Harrington como presidente de DeSales Media, responsable de *Tablet/Nuestra Voz* y NET TV y sus otras actividades. Me sorprendieron completamente estas citas y de ninguna manera las busqué. Mi preferencia personal sería quedarme aquí durante los cinco años restantes antes de llegar a la edad de jubilación de 75. Sin embargo, de la misma manera que vine aquí bajo la dirección de nuestro obispo, también debo aceptar su visión más amplia para las necesidades de los sacerdotes y del pueblo de Dios en nuestra diócesis. Su nombre es Monseñor Cuong Pham, nacido en Vietnam pero criado aquí en Queens, un sacerdote de la Diócesis de Brooklyn que asistió a nuestros seminarios diocesanos y fue ordenado hace veinte años. Habla con fluidez muchos idiomas, incluso el español y italiano. Por favor, bríndele su mayor cooperación y apoyo, como lo ha hecho conmigo desde mi primer día con usted hace trece años.

Tengo otra noticia relacionada. Además de mi propia partida, el Padre Peter Nguyen también está siendo trasladado desde aquí para convertirse en asociado en la parroquia de San Francisco de Asís en Astoria, también a partir del 30 de junio. Él también ha estado aquí en esta parroquia durante trece años, e incluso ya como hermano religioso antes de eso. Le agradezco su gran ayuda a lo largo de estos años, porque realmente ha sido un hermano sacerdote indispensable para mí. Habrá un reemplazo para el Padre Peter, pero aún no ha sido nombrado.
