Dear Parishioners,

As we gather to celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Blessed Trinity, I invite you to reflect deeply on the nature of relationships and community.

The renowned French philosopher Jean-Paul Sartre once famously remarked, "Hell is other people." Many of us can relate to this sentiment at certain moments in our lives. After experiencing a series of negative interactions, we often yearn for solitude, envisioning a state of blissful isolation. However, even the most introverted among us occasionally crave human connection and companionship. Deep within, we understand that true wholeness comes from being in relationships with others. Reflecting on the happiest moments of our lives, we often find they involved some form of communion or community, a genuine connection. Even in an age marked by rampant individualism, we instinctively know that no one is an isolated island.

The Solemnity of the Trinity reminds us that this truth about human connection is even more profoundly true for God. At the core of God's existence is a community—a communion of persons—a network of relationships. The Gospel reading today from Matthew 28:16-20 highlights the commission of the disciples by Jesus, where He commands them to baptize "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." This directive underlines the integral relationship within the Trinity and extends it to the mission of the Church. The deep bond within the Trinity could not remain confined but was generously poured out upon us through the sending of the Holy Spirit. This divine community invites us into the essence of God's loving nature. The community present within God is not an exclusive enclave but an inclusive one that extends an open invitation to each of us.

If God exists as a communion of love—a loving community—and we are created in God's image, then our purpose, our vocation, is to foster communities of love that reflect God's very essence. Our first encounter with such a loving community typically occurs within our families. We are born into families, none of which is perfect, and we continually grapple with various challenges. Yet, the family has the potential to become a loving communion that mirrors and embodies the love found within God.

Beyond the family, the Church is called to be a community of love. On the eve of His crucifixion, Jesus spoke to His disciples, saying, "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you... Love one another as I have loved you." Jesus envisioned the Church as a loving community that emulates the love shared within God's community. Although the Church, the assembly of Jesus's followers, has often fallen short of this divine vision, the Holy Spirit continuously reminds us of Jesus's teachings and our lofty calling. With the Spirit's guidance, we must persist in striving to embody this calling. Each parish, as a local expression of the Church, is summoned to radiate the loving communion that resides within God.

Whenever we take action to forge a family, build a parish, or cultivate a community, we are acting in a Trinitarian manner, even if we are unaware of the Trinity's significance in those moments. Every time we bring people together in ways that affirm and uplift them, we are embodying the spirit of the Trinity. This is the invitation and challenge presented by the Solemnity of the Trinity. Though it may initially appear distant from our everyday lives, it is, in fact, a deeply practical celebration. It reminds us of the purpose that should guide us in our day-to-day existence.

As we embark on the month of June this week, dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity takes on a profound dimension. The Sacred Heart, brimming with divine love, serves as a powerful manifestation of God's boundless love for humanity. This love is the foundation of our call to live in loving community, mirroring the divine communion of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Let us embrace this divine love and strive to create communities that reflect the heart of God.

Queridos Feligreses,

Al reunirnos para celebrar la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad, los invito a reflexionar profundamente sobre la naturaleza de las relaciones y la comunidad.

El renombrado filósofo francés Jean-Paul Sartre dijo una vez: “El infierno son los otros”. Muchos de nosotros podemos identificarnos con este sentimiento en ciertos momentos de nuestras vidas. Después de experimentar una serie de interacciones negativas, a menudo anhelamos la soledad, imaginando un estado de aislamiento dichoso. Sin embargo, incluso los más introvertidos entre nosotros ocasionalmente desean la conexión humana y la compañía. En lo más profundo, entendemos que la verdadera plenitud proviene de estar en relación con los demás. Al reflexionar sobre los momentos más felices de nuestras vidas, a menudo encontramos que involucraron alguna forma de comunión o comunidad, una conexión genuina. Incluso en una era marcada por el individualismo desenfrenado, sabemos instintivamente que nadie es una isla aislada.

La Solemnidad de la Trinidad nos recuerda que esta verdad sobre la conexión humana es aún más profundamente cierta para Dios. En el centro de la existencia de Dios hay una comunidad, una comunión de personas, una red de relaciones. La lectura del Evangelio de hoy, tomada de Mateo 28:16-20, resalta la comisión de los discípulos por parte de Jesús, donde Él les manda bautizar “en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo”. Esta directiva subraya la relación integral dentro de la Trinidad y la extiende a la misión de la Iglesia. El profundo vínculo dentro de la Trinidad no pudo permanecer confinado, sino que se derramó generosamente sobre nosotros mediante el envío del Espíritu Santo. Esta comunidad divina nos invita a la esencia de la naturaleza amorosa de Dios. La comunidad presente dentro de Dios no es un enclave exclusivo, sino uno inclusivo que extiende una invitación abierta a cada uno de nosotros.

Si Dios existe como una comunión de amor, una comunidad amorosa, y nosotros estamos creados a imagen de Dios, entonces nuestro propósito, nuestra vocación, es fomentar comunidades de amor que reflejen la esencia misma de Dios. Nuestro primer encuentro con una comunidad amorosa típicamente ocurre dentro de nuestras familias. Nacemos en familias, ninguna de las cuales es perfecta, y continuamente lidiamos con diversos desafíos. Sin embargo, la familia tiene el potencial de convertirse en una comunión amorosa que refleje y encarne el amor encontrado dentro de Dios.

Más allá de la familia, la Iglesia está llamada a ser una comunidad de amor. En la víspera de su crucifixión, Jesús habló a sus discípulos, diciendo: “Como el Padre me ha amado, así también yo os he amado... Amaos unos a otros como yo os he amado”. Jesús imaginó la Iglesia como una comunidad amorosa que emule el amor compartido dentro de la comunidad de Dios. Aunque la Iglesia, la asamblea de los seguidores de Jesús, a menudo ha fallado en alcanzar esta visión divina, el Espíritu Santo nos recuerda continuamente las enseñanzas de Jesús y nuestro elevado llamado. Con la guía del Espíritu, debemos persistir en esforzarnos por encarnar este llamado. Cada parroquia, como expresión local de la Iglesia, está llamada a irradiar la comunión amorosa que reside dentro de Dios.

Cada vez que tomamos acción para formar una familia, construir una parroquia o cultivar una comunidad, estamos actuando de manera trinitaria, incluso si no somos conscientes del significado de la Trinidad en esos momentos. Cada vez que reunimos a las personas de manera que las afirmamos y elevamos, estamos encarnando el espíritu de la Trinidad. Esta es la invitación y el desafío presentados por la Solemnidad de la Trinidad. Aunque pueda parecer distante de nuestras vidas cotidianas, es, de hecho, una celebración profundamente práctica. Nos recuerda el propósito que debe guiarnos en nuestra existencia diaria.

Al comenzar el mes de junio esta semana, dedicado al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad adquiere una dimensión profunda. El Sagrado Corazón, rebosante de amor divino, sirve como una manifestación poderosa del amor ilimitado de Dios por la humanidad. Este amor es el fundamento de nuestro llamado a vivir en comunidad amorosa, reflejando la comunión divina del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Abracemos este amor divino y esforcémonos por crear comunidades que reflejen el corazón de Dios.
