Prayer for Truth

Dear Lord, Your prophets were those who spoke Your Truth. Help me to be a speaker of truth as well, one who reminds of Your love, encourages the lowly, and points ever more deeply to You. Amen

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Recently I watched a bunch of YouTube videos on how to optimize willpower in the face of weakness. The message was: do not accept your weakness. Crush it. Dominate it. In one video, however, at the end of a rant by a willpower coach, the muscular stoic admitted, "You'll never actually get what you want, no matter how hard you try." Amazingly, he admitted that willpower alone is not sufficient for us weak-willed humans. What does God want us to do with our weaknesses, if crushing them with willpower won't work? For example, what should I do with my tendency to arrogance and self-isolation? Or my procrastination? Or my intellectual and physical limitations? Or my selfishness? The counter-intuitive answer is clear in this week's words from St Paul, "**I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses in order that the power of Christ may dwell in me** (2 Cor. 12:9)." Boast of our weaknesses? Paul isn't promoting weak-mindedness or laziness. Rather, he perceives that Jesus loves us not despite our weaknesses but because of them. Boasting of our weakness means claiming human will is not all we have. It means turning to God whenever we feel weak, which-let's face it-is almost all the time. When we do, we learn to love our weaknesses, because it's there that we meet the strength of Christ. This week, I challenge us to find ways to boast not in willpower but in weakness.

Dear brothers and sisters,

Next Saturday, July 13, we will celebrate in a solemn way the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, our parish's Patronal Feast. This occasion holds significant meaning for our community and is one of the most cherished annual events we have.

Throughout history, Mary has been honored under various titles. "Our Lady of Mount Carmel" originates from the remarkable experience of the prophet Elijah on Mount Carmel, located in present-day northwestern Israel. Elijah challenged the worshipers of false gods to a contest, calling upon their gods to light a fire for the holocaust offering. In a demonstration of unwavering faith, Elijah drenched his own wood and offering with water before invoking the Lord, who promptly answered with fire. Since then, the mountain has been revered as sacred, attracting hermits who dedicated their lives to austerity and prayer.

Centuries later, when the Carmelite Order was established, they adopted Our Lady of Mount Carmel as a representation of their spirituality, which encompasses both Marian devotion and deep contemplation. Since the 15th century, devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel has focused on the Brown Scapular. According to tradition, Mary bestowed the Scapular upon Saint Simon Stock as a sign of her divine love and protection. Wearing the Scapular carries a host of promises, with the foremost being eternal salvation through the intercession of our heavenly Mother.

Devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel has always been a defining characteristic of our parish. When our parish and school were founded, our Founding Fathers chose to entrust the community to Our Lady under this title. For the past 184 years, the people of our parish have sought her protection and guidance, finding solace in this particular title. Today, this devotion continues to hold deep significance for all of us.

I am thrilled to announce that on this highly anticipated Feast Day, we will be graced with the presence of His Eminence, Christophe Cardinal Pierre, the Apostolic Nuncio to the United States. As the Personal Representative of Pope Francis to our nation, His Eminence will undoubtedly fill our community with extraordinary grace.

I wholeheartedly urge every one of you to mark your calendars for the grand celebrations next Saturday, which include a Street Procession starting from Mary's Garden at 4PM; a Solemn Mass at 5PM and Outdoor Festivities afterwards, featuring an array of captivating music, dances, and selections of international food that will bring delight to everyone. Please plan to come in your native dress to show the cultural richness of our parish.

Together, let us pay homage to Our Lady in ways that resonate with her heart. May the celebration of our parish's Patronal Feast be an occasion of grace and conversion for each of us.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

El próximo sábado 13 de julio, celebraremos solemnemente la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo, la Fiesta Patronal de nuestra parroquia. Esta ocasión tiene un significado importante para nuestra comunidad y es uno de los eventos anuales más queridos que tenemos.

A lo largo de la historia, María ha sido honrada con diversos títulos. “Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo” se origina en la notable experiencia del profeta Elías en el Monte Carmelo, ubicado en la actualidad en el noroeste de Israel. Elías desafió a los adoradores de falsos dioses a un concurso, pidiendo a sus dioses que encendieran un fuego para la ofrenda del holocausto. En una demostración de fe inquebrantable, Elías empapó su propia madera y ofrenda con agua antes de invocar al Señor, quien respondió de inmediato con fuego. Desde entonces, la montaña ha sido venerada como sagrada, atrayendo a ermitaños que dedicaron sus vidas a la austeridad y la oración.

Siglos después, cuando se estableció la Orden del Carmen, adoptaron a Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo como representación de su espiritualidad, que abarca tanto la devoción mariana como la profunda contemplación. Desde el siglo XV, la devoción a Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo se ha centrado en el Escapulario Marrón. Según la tradición, María entregó el Escapulario a San Simón Stock como señal de su amor y protección divina. Usar el Escapulario conlleva una serie de promesas, siendo la principal la salvación eterna a través de la intercesión de nuestra Madre celestial.

La devoción a Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo siempre ha sido una característica definitoria de nuestra parroquia. Cuando se fundaron nuestra parroquia y escuela, nuestros Padres Fundadores decidieron confiar a la comunidad a Nuestra Señora bajo este título. Durante los últimos 184 años, la gente de nuestra parroquia ha buscado su protección y orientación, encontrando consuelo en este título en particular. Hoy en día, esta devoción sigue teniendo un profundo significado para todos nosotros.

Me complace anunciar que, en este esperado Día de la Fiesta, contaremos con la presencia de Su Eminencia el Cardenal Christophe Pierre, el Nuncio Apostólico en los Estados Unidos. La visita del Representante Personal del propio Papa Francisco sin duda llenará nuestra comunidad de una gracia extraordinaria. Por favor venir todos en sus propias costumbres nativas para mostrar la riqueza cultural de nuestra parroquia.

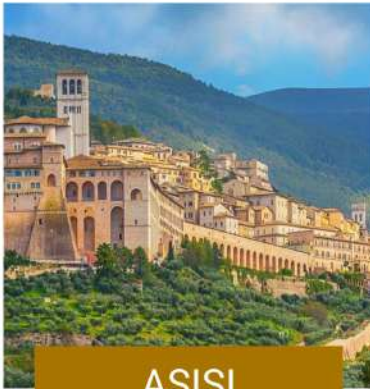

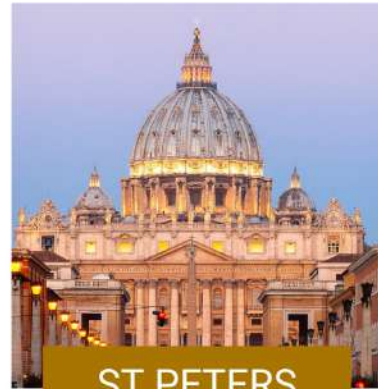
